

Let's start with German - Lesson 3

Hallo (*Hallo*)

Guten Morgen. (*Good morning.*)

Guten Tag. (*Good afternoon.*)

Guten Abend. (*Good evening.*)

- The German word for **hello** is **hallo**
Imagine saying **hello** to an angel with a **halo**.
- The German word for **good** is **gut**
Imagine a **good gut** feeling with this new friend.
- The German word for **morning** is **Morgen**
- The German word for **day** is **Tag**
Imagine your children playing **tag** all **day** long.
- The German word for **evening** is **Abend**
Imagine going on a **bender** in the **evening**.

Tschüss (*Bye*)

Bis bald (*See you*)

Auf Wiedersehen (*See you again*)

Auf Wiederhören (*Hear you again*)

- The German word for **goodbye** is **tschüss**
Imagine how many ways you can **choose** to say **goodbye**.
- The German word for **until** is **bis**
Imagine making good **biz until** the credit crunch.
- The German word for **soon** is **bald**
Imagine looking in a mirror and thinking: I shall **soon** be **bald**.
- The German word for **again** is **wieder**
Imagine eating **again** and again and getting **wider** and wider.

- The German word for to **see** is **sehen**
Imagine talking to a hen: **say, hen**, what have you **seen**?
- The German word for to **hear** is **hören**
Imagine how **her wren** could **hear** its mate due to its loud and conspicuous bird song.
